OZCF Library—Librarian Required!




Sports and Youth Committees

Report on FEZANA AGM by Teenaz Javat

A visit to the Ontario Zoroastrian Community Foundation (OZCF) means prayers, gambhar, cricket or camp. But on the evening of April 23 as I entered the hall, I was pleasantly surprised to see it morphed into a boardroom- crisp white covers draped over tables set to seat all 24 delegates still arriving at the gates.

As the representatives and their spouses came in there was much back-slapping. The Daruwalas from Florida met the Panthakis from Mississauga after almost 50 years! The Dastoors met the Patels, Collector and Mehta agreed to disagree, Rivetna came with his erudite wife and son while their daughter took fastidious notes. Pastakia and Gandhi came to enlighten and in some cases set the record straight. It was clear right from the outset that the meeting was more than just a coming together of people. Those assembled represented a microcosm of the larger Zoroastrian community living and working in North America. The setting lent itself to the dissemination of thoughts and ideas which can then be taken to their respective associations for mandate. Safe to say, it is at these gatherings where ideas take birth. They are spawned, vigorously debated upon, massaged, tweaked and set on their road to fruition.

After the benediction by Ervad Kobad Zarolia and mandatory introductions by President Bomi Patel, the motley audience was treated to a pre-AGM audio-visual presentation by Behram Pastakia on how the tenets of our faith are being tested at the grass-root level in the form of Operation Eyesight. Behram went onto remind us how important it is to keep our faith in the spotlight. He mentioned that 2010 is a landmark year as it was 1,000 years ago that the great bard Ferdowsi of Tus completed the epic of kings-Shahnameh. Dolly Dastoor Editor-in-chief of the FEZANA journal announced that the winter issue will be dedicated to this great epic and its author who started the book as a dowry for his daughter and took 30 years to complete.

And then there was food-Chicken curry chaval and lots of kachumbar.

Day two began just the way day one ended- with more food. Kermin Byramjee and her band of foodies cooked up 100 poras and all were treated to a delectable nashta of pora-pau and garam chai/coffee. The two sessions for the day were mostly dedicated to following a set agenda. A report by President Bomi Patel, Secretary Firuzi Poonevalla, and the feisty treasurer Katayun Kapadia. Accolades and praise were showered on Katayun as she leaves the position after rendering yeoman service for 4 years. Each representative was allocated 5 minutes to brief all present on their individual associations.

The session was interspersed with tea/coffee breaks comprising naan khatai and bhakras followed by a delectable bhel poori/finger food lunch of fish pakoras, chat and meat kebabs. As the debates and presentation continued the members were invited to a dinner program arranged by the OZCF at the Holiday Inn in Oakville. The guests were treated to a light-hearted talk by Prof Enrico G. Raffaelli who while extolling the virtues of our faith told the audience how much he loved watching "Little Zizou".

"The Religion of Zarathustra has not ceased to fascinate me," said Raffaelli of the University of Toronto. "While ancient customs and ceremonies are impossible to practise in a modern context, we need to expand our program at U of T as Toronto is the new centre of Zoroastrians in the world." 280 students have over 8 years studied Introduction to Zoroastrianism at the undergraduate level, which is more than the student-turnout at the prestigious School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS) in London, England. The meetings continued with the final session being held in the morning at the Holiday Inn hotel. The afternoon was rounded off by a session arranged by the World Zoroastrian Chamber of Commerce (Toronto Chapter) who had four speakers that were followed by a Zoroastrian briefing everyone on his new business venture and looking for guidance from those around him.

The OZCF would like to thank FEZANA for providing them the opportunity to host the AGM and it also helped provide a better insight into the FEZANA sub-committees and how each association can try and benefit from the wealth of knowledge that encompasses all the associate members.
