This is the last Newsletter of 2011 & we are bringing in the New Year of 2012. The OZCF has completed nine progressive years of its existence. I would like to take a moment to reflect on what we have accomplished and look forward to where we are going.

- We have purchased 10.2 acres of land.
- Completed the renovation of the existing garage into a beautiful hall which is being used extensively for various activities such as entertainment, religious events, Jashan. Gahambars, Muktad, Navjotes, weddings, funeral ceremonies, Senior's and Pranayam Yoga and exercise classes, children events, Nataks and many other activities.
- We have received the permit to Install the patio cover with skylights and the storage shed to free up the space in the hall
- Installed a removable stage donated by our Yoga seniors
- Installed curbs to protect hall walls
- Installed catch basin to drain water puddles in the entrance of our parking lot
 - Parking lot leveled, covered with asphalt grindings and compacted
- Purchased banquette style chairs, new round and square tables and caddies
- Many other planed improvements to be completed funds permitting.
- Set up a master Plan Committee to prepare a comprehensive plan to maximize the use of our land, in relation with Town of Oakville North Secondary plan.
- Set up a Place of worship advisory committee to prepare a detailed report on the viability, sustainability, funding etc to give the community in-depth information for the decision making process.
- Set up By-Law subcommittee to review new Bill 65 to check and amend our Bylaws in relation to this bill that will have some effect on all charitable and not-for-profit organizations. The committee is expected to be ready with their recommendations and amendments to our bylaws by the Dec. or January 2012.

This year has been challenging and extremely busy with several activities or functions being held at the ZRCC almost bi-weekly! This proves much value of having our own property that can be

used in many ways.

While our Advisory Committee and Master Plan Committee are busy preparing their report on our place of worship, I request all the community members to take interest and come forward to help whether it is financial, physical or moral or otherwise to work in unity to move closer to our vision. The Board of Directors cannot do it all without your help and active participation and involvement!

I would like to wish Seasons Greetings, a Happy New Year and say Thank You to the Board of Directors, subcommittee members, and to all our members for your continued support, cooperation, assistance. We are looking forward to an exciting phase and seeing the community unite even more to achieve the vision and goals of the OZCF.

We have managed to include the Autodialer message itself on the website which has been done for Bereavement messages in the last month. This gives you the ability to listen to the Autodialer message again, in case you missed it or did not quite 'get it'. You would need sound on your computer or internet device to listen to the message and it can be accessed by computer and certain cell phones. The web site will be undergoing some other cosmetic changes over the next 2 months and we will highlight these once they have been completed.

As We Grow—Progress at the Property

In recent months much work has been carried out at the ZRCC property. Here's some detail on these accomplishments:

Folding Stage – As many of you are aware, our Seniors meet weekly to practise Yoga. You may be unaware to know that this indefatigable group regularly collects donations amongst themselves. Recently, enough money had been collected which was donated toward installing a folding stage in the main hall. This allows us to fold up the stage and use the space at the front of the hall if required.

New Chairs – you'll get to view what takes place on that new stage on comfortable, new, banquet hall style chairs which the Board had recently ordered. Expect to see these in the main hall at the time of Navroze.

Paving the Way and Catch Basin – granular asphalt shavings have been deposited, levelled, graded, and compacted in the parking lot. This will reduce the accumulation of mud and water which used to form large pools during heavy precipitation. In addition, a catch basin has been installed in the lowest part at the west end of the driveway. This will further curtail large pooling of water as it drains into the basin which will then drain into the creek at the west end of our property.

Permission Granted – we have, at last, received approval by the Town to construct the awning over the patio. This will allow us to make use of the patio during intense weather conditions, effectively doubling our spatial use (main hall + patio). This permit ensues the one received to construct the storage shed which will be attached to the south end of the awning. Installation of both the awning and the shed are set to begin shortly.

New Tables - 20 six feet round blow molded plastic tables, 10 blow molded plastic card tables, two storage caddies for round tables, and two storage caddies for existing rectangle tables have also been purchased.

Motion Detection Lights – No more darkness in front of the house as motion detection lights have been installed at its entrance.

One Match Stem Cell Campaign Calling all 18 – 50 year olds





The ZSO and OZCF are excited to announce the launch of a One Match Stem Cell Campaign with the Canadian Blood Services Stem Cell and Marrow Network.

What is One Match?

- •OneMatch Stem Cell and Marrow Network is responsible for finding and matching volunteer donors to patients who require stem cell transplants
- •Canadian Blood Services' OneMatch is a member of an international network of registries
- •By agreeing to make their donor data available worldwide, international registries have significantly increased the odds of being able to find a matching donor for any patient, anywhere in the world

Why Register?

- •Only 30% of patients will find a match within their family and 70% of Canadians rely on a generous donation from an unrelated person
- •The probability that someone who needs a bone marrow or stem cell transplant will find a match within his or her own community is high
- •For many patients, finding a stem cell donor is like searching for a needle in a haystack
- •By the time a person is in need of a match they are at a point of crisis and need to find a match as soon as possible. Registering as a potential donor saves valuable time

Process to register as a Donor: Join OneMatch Stem Cell and Marrow Network.

- •To register, you will complete a short health assessment questionnaire and consent to be listed on the database
- •Visit www.onematch.ca go to join and fill out the online registration form Or
- •Call 1 888 2 DONATE (1-888-236-6283) to have a registration package mailed to you
- •Once they receive the health assessment and consent form, they will contact you to make arrangements to have you tested or send a simple swab testing kit to your home
- •Your typing results will be added to the their database, and you will be included when they search for possible donors for patients in need

Basic Eligibility:

- ●Be between 17 and 50 years of age
- •Volunteers should be committed to helping any patient in need
- •Meet certain health-related criteria
- •Fall between certain height and weight levels

You can change your mind at anytime. However, we encourage you think about whether you would be able to donate before joining the network, a match could be made a number of years from when you join.


