

Join FEZANA in Celebrating & Participating in The Cyrus Cylinder Tour of USA

Dear Presidents/Representatives of Member Associations. Corresponding Members, Committee Chairs & Zarathushtis in NA:

The Cyrus Cylinder is a 2600-year old object of modern importance, and a symbol of multi-culturalism, tolerance, diversity, and human rights. The Cylinder, a replica of which is enshrined at the United Nations as the first charter of human rights, is on a permanent exhibit at the British Museum.



This year, it will be on exhibit, along with several other significant objects of Persian antiquity, including one depicting a Zarathushti priest, for the first time at five major museums across the U.S.: Washington D.C. (March 9 – April 28, 2013); Houston (May 3 – June 14, 2013); New York (June 20 – August 4, 2013); San Francisco (August 9 – September 22, 2013); and Los Angeles (October 2 – December 2, 2013).

This US national tour is officially sponsored by the Iran Heritage Foundation of America (IHF), working in collaboration with the British Museum. We Zarathushtis are especially attuned to the significance of the Cyrus Cylinder; and as the organization representing Zarathushti interests in North America. FEZANA has received a special invitation to partner with IHF in this effort.




Family Day 2013

An appeal

At present we are running a small guest house in Udvada called Katila Lodge having only four rooms. When we started this project, our aim was to enable those Zarthostis to visit Udvada who cannot afford to spend more. With this in mind we fixed the rate of Rs.20/-per day as lodging charges in the year 2001. After 12 years this is now raised to Rs.40/- per day.

Some time back we were gifted a bigger house by the name of Bharda House in Udvada. The building was in a dilapidated condition, which is now demolished and new boundary wall constructed. The reconstruction of the building will start this month. We propose to make 12 to 16 self contained rooms with modern amenities, which will be offered to Parsi / Irani Zarthostis (coming to visit Pak Iranshah), at a very reasonable rate. We shall also provide meals at reasonable rates.

Visiting Udvada is getting more and more expensive now, even if one stays in dharamshala. We have decided to run this project on 'no profit' basis on the lines of our Katila Lodge, to enable more Zarthostis to visit Udvada, who cannot afford present day costs. In fact we shall have to subsidise the project from our corpus.

The total cost of construction of the building will be about Rs. 1.2 crores. So far we have received donations of over Rs.30 lacs. However we still require nearly a crore for this project. We do not intend to use up funds from our modest corpus, interest from which is used for carrying out various service activities for Zarthostis.

We shall be putting up a large marble plaque near the entrance on which, names of donors of above Rs.1 lac will be listed. Moreover individual granite plaque will be put up for donors offering Rs.10 lacs &above. It is our humble appeal to your good selves to consider giving maximum donation for this worthy project.
