## PLACE OF WORSHIP ADVISORY COMMITTEE

### PROGRESS REPORT BY PHIL SIDHWA, CHAIR PWAC

The Place of Worship Advisory Committee has been meeting frequently to develop strategies for our sub-committees to move the project forward. Our fundraising sub-committee is busily working on developing a framework to raise funds across North America as well as internationally. To set a good example to outside donors, we look forward to the OZCF membership taking the lead on donating generously towards this project, just as we did when we bought our land, then built the hall and now sit debt free on this valuable property. All funds raised at our 2016 Inaugural Gala will go towards the new place of worship.

The governance sub-committee is developing strategies for the future management of the facility. The entertainment, communications and public relations sub-committees are developing information packages to assist fundraising activities and communicate our message worldwide. The finance sub-committee is developing financial and administrative protocols around managing donations, loan arrangements and construction activities. Soon to follow will be the activities of the construction, project management and engineering sub-committee. Our Adaran commissioning sub-committee is investigating the processes and rituals required for consecration from learned scholars and priests.

In November, the Town of Oakville Planning and Development Council approved the removal of the house from the Oakville Register of Properties of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. This is a major step forward for us and gives us the flexibility to demolish the house if required. These reports will be available on our website soon.

We continue to meet with Town of Oakville and Region of Halton staff to develop a suitable approach around planning and zoning matters, together with our planning and engineering consultants and architect.

2016 promises to be a busy year for PWAC and its sub-committees. We are fortunate to have such dedicated and hard working members working together towards this common goal. We always welcome additional members on our sub-committees, women and men, young and old, especially those with experience and interest in these areas. Please contact us should you be interested in sitting on a sub-committee and join us on this fabulous and fulfilling journey.

## MASS MARKETING FRAUD AND CYBERCRIME AWARENESS PRESENTATION

On November 15, 2015 a presentation was held by the RCMP and the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre covering Mass Marketing Fraud, Identity Theft, other scams – and how to avoid them. The presentation was well attended by over 60 members. Nearly 80 percent of mass marketing fraud is conducted by organized crime groups and is currently the second most common criminal activity funding terrorist activities. The presentation was delivered by CAFC Volunteer SeniorBuster: Brock Godfrey and RCMP Constable Jennifer George at no charge.



Brock joined PhoneBusters in 1997 as a Volunteer SeniorBuster. He has been instrumental in educating the public and raising awareness of illegal mass marketing fraud and Id theft: which is clearly the most successful and effective long-term strategy in reducing the number of fraud victims.

Jennifer George is a Constable with 10 years' experience with the Mounties. She is attached to the Mass Marketing Fraud Unit of the Greater Toronto Area, part of the Commercial Crime Section, located in Milton. This is her third year working with the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre.
