A huge congratulations to our entire Place of Worship Advisory Committee who have worked tirelessly for many years to get us to this point. They now embark on the second phase of their project. Please read below the update from our Place of Worship Advisory Committee Chair Phil Sidhwa.

March brings with it a very busy time with Muktad, Navroze and Khordad Saal. During the 5 Gatha days from 16 – 20 March, we will have Muktad prayers at the ZRCC, as we remember the souls of our dearly departed. On 21st March, we will celebrate Jamshedi Navroze with a Jashan followed by dinner. You must register if you wish to join us for dinner. Please see below for more information.

For the past few years, we have had a very busy Youth Committee. Besides organizing a lot of youth events, they routinely collaborate with the Seniors, Sports, Entertainment and Fundraising committees, and Scouts to deliver consistently great events. Even COVID and the lockdown couldn't slow them as they pivoted and stepped up with the Helping Hands program to help all seniors with weekly grocery deliveries and kept the community engaged with weekly entertainment via bingo. The success of Quarantine Bingo translated into a Bingo Fundraiser to help subsidize costs for participants attending the Youth Congress in London later this year. With a wide variety of attractive prizes ranging from coffee machines, sporting goods, back and neck massagers, Segway, Air Canada vouchers and Maple Leafs tickets, the event was sold out and excitement levels were high all night. We got amazing feedback from the event and requests to host more of them. A huge thank you to Cyrus Patel who donated the sporting goods on behalf of the World Zoroastrian Chamber of Commerce, Meherab Chothia for the Leafs tickets and to our other anonymous donors.

The next Youth event is another Fundraiser for the Congress – Car Rally 2023. A scavenger hunt around Mississauga and Oakville areas solving clues and completing tasks. The Youth Committee is also embarking on a new multi-year project. In collaboration with the youth at the Zoroastrian Society of Ontario (ZSO) and the Federation of Zoroastrian Associations of North America (FEZANA), we are jointly preparing a bid to host the 2027 World Zoroastrian Youth Congress in Toronto. 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PLACE OF WORSHIP ADVISORY COMMITTEE

We are pleased to inform the community that the Town of Oakville has given us Site Plan Approval (SPA) and we are proceeding to submit drawings and application for a Building Permit. This is a major milestone for us considering the years we have spent going through the rezoning and SPA phases of this project. We thank the community for your patience and continued support.

We have prepared drawings and tender documents and contacted six contractors to gauge interest in bidding, of which five are interested in the work. We will put out tenders in March and have tenders submitted by early May. We will then meet with the community to discuss prices, arrangements and next steps.

As construction pricing is expected to be higher than monies we currently have in cash and pledges, we count on community members to donate generously to this wonderful cause.

We will keep you updated as we progress through the building permit and tendering process. May Ahura Mazda always bless our community.


















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RAPTORS GAME:
